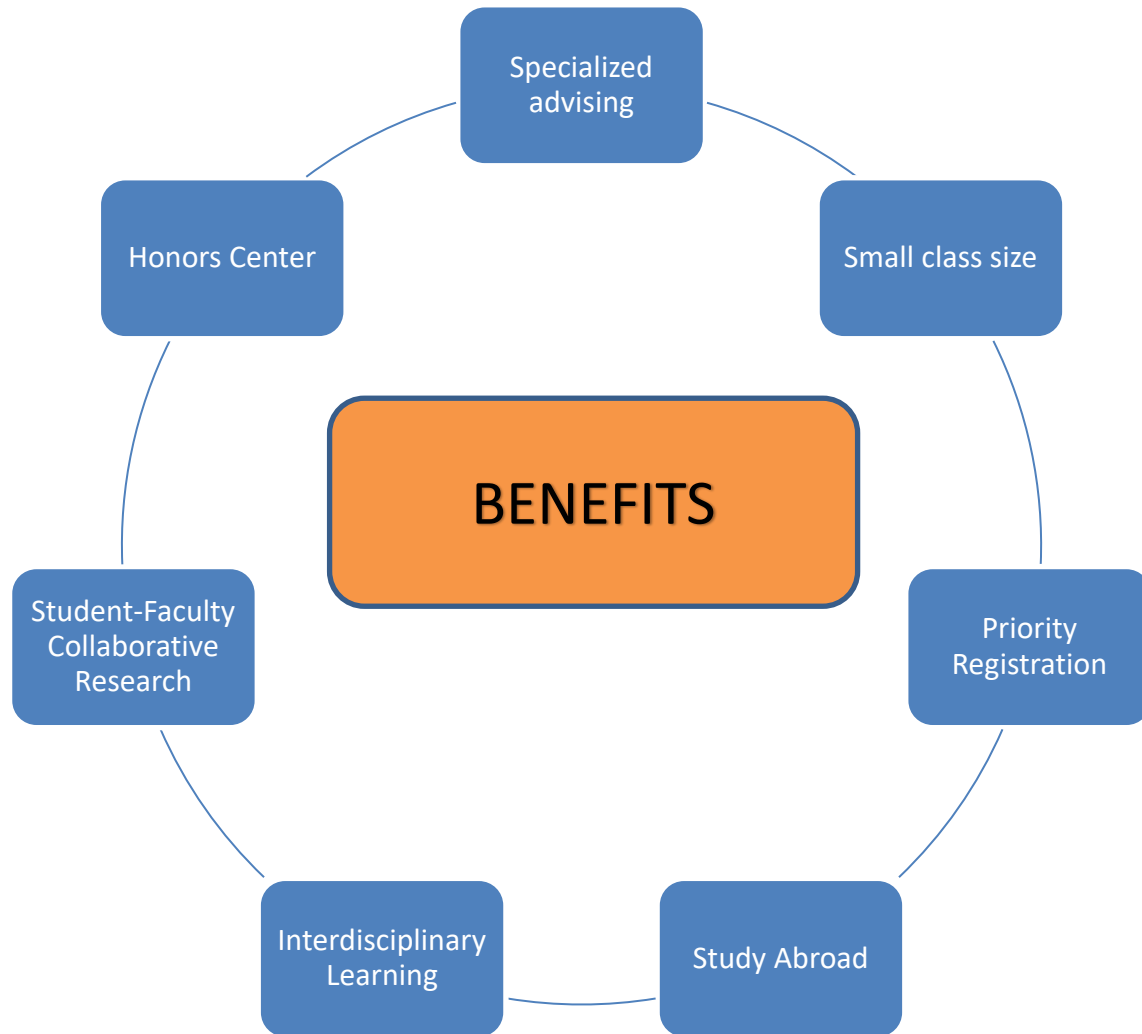

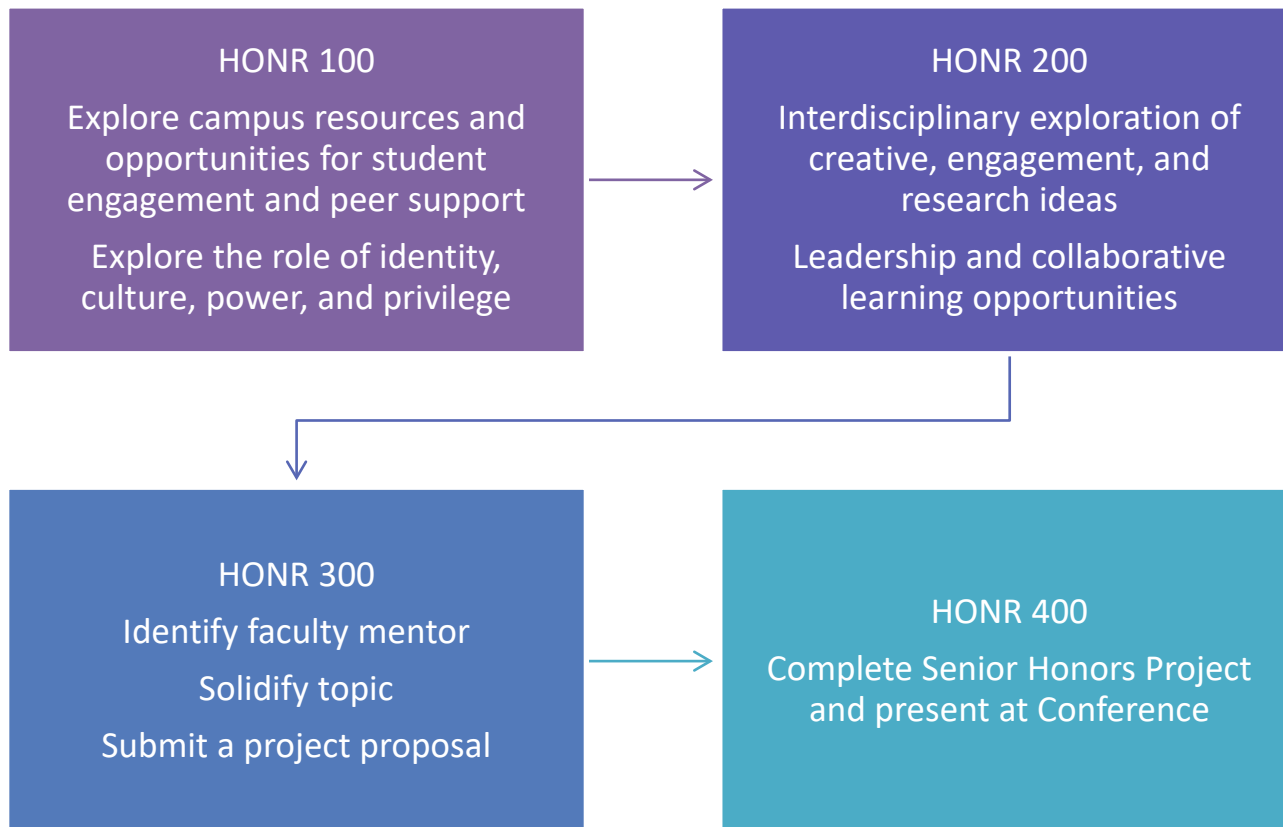

  - Practicum-based projects
  - Projects related to study abroad and global education, Disciplinary-based portfolios
  - Entrepreneurial activities



## Creative Project

- Creative activities, such as:

  - Fall 2024: June 1, 2024
- **Application Materials**
  - Copy of Transcripts
  - Two Essays (exempt for HTCC students)
  - Contact information of 2 references (exempt for HTCC students)

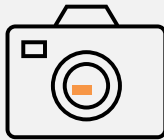
